

Janie's Top Wardrobe Management Tips

Use only appropriate coat hangers - banish wire hangers they leave lines on your clothes.

Buy for who you are today!

Invest in good accessories to dress outfits up and down.

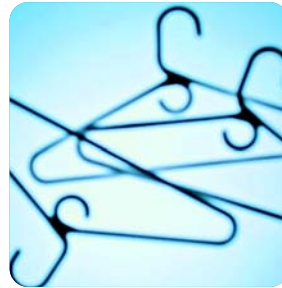
Re-evaluate and 'weed' your wardrobe regularly – at least once a year! Preferably each season.

Understand your colour direction.



Don't buy on impulse. Buy for your life style, the work that you do and to make your wardrobe flexible.

Hang different garment categories together – enables easier perusal and mixing and matching.



Include make-up as part of your wardrobe and re-evaluate every 3-4 months. Cosmetics are preserved by the same chemicals that keep food fresh and they expire.

Fasten buttons, zips, empty pockets, remove all jewellery.

Hang clothes up, outside wardrobe or in the fresh air, for a few hours/overnight after each wearing.

Be aware of your body shape, line, scale, and proportions.

Invest in a full length mirror and always check your back view.

Pay particular attention to eye make-up, **mascara** is worst (the perfect breeding ground for germs). Renew every 6-8 weeks.



Never put away clothes that require attention eg. repair/cleaning.



Shoes: Scotchguard when new. Always put away clean. Use shoe trees.

Keep sewing kit handy for repairs while watching T.V. Keep scissors near ironing board to snip loose ends.

Know the **'must haves'** for each season.
